### Whitney Plantation

Kick off your week by visiting the Whitney Plantation (The Whitney Institute), a non-profit museum focusing on the history of a former sugar plantation that operated from 1752 to 1975. Spanning 200 acres, the plantation highlights the story of slavery in the U.S. from the perspectives of the enslaved Africans, African Americans, and Creoles of Color who built America's wealth. Join the staff for a walking tour that explores the unique intersection of history and storytelling. Please wear comfortable shoes and clothing, as the tour includes accessible grounds and lower-level areas of the buildings.
